(Recommend: No. 4 Silver Black Velvet 3000S) Cheap "paintbox brushes" or stencil brushes for mixing Palette or small plastic cups (deeper wells are useful) walnut ink (walnut crystals from https://www.johnnealbooks.com/ are easy to pack) 1 wide brush (3 or more inches wide: cheap foam brush, house painting brush, or Japanese Hake brush) 2 sheets white Rives BFK 250GSM* (22 x 30)* I sheet arches text wove* 25 x 20* I sheet of cover weight paper for your book* (18" X 12" or larger- Arches Black Cover* is one of my favorites.) tracing paper Transparent yellow iron oxide acrylic (2-4 people can share a 2 oz tube of acrylic, (Golden is the preferred brand, can travel in carry-on). Permanent white gouache (Windsor-Newton) or Dr Martin's bleedproof white Watercolor: As long as you have a tube of good quality (not student grade!) watercolor in red, yellow and blue, you will have enough to play with. All you need is 3 colors. If you wish to try a new palette, and 2 versions of each primary color: Yellows: New Gamboge & Hansa or lemon. Reds: (from Daniel Smith) Transparent Pyrrole Orange & Alizarin Crimson . Blues: Phthalo Blue (any shade) and Indigo. Embroidery or bookbinding needle Glue stick **Right triangle** Linen thread (any thickness will work) Embroidery thread Paper clips (about 6) and a rubber band ***** OPTIONAL: (YOU DO NOT NEED TO BRING THESE) Mat knife and cutting mat Bone folder Water soluble graphite pencils Art Graf or Lyra, Water Soluble Graphite Crayon and or Block Other tubes of gouache or watercolor: Peach Black (Holbein) is a lovely matte black paper/ collage scraps black china marker*
